Seeking On-Call Road Crew Member

Primary Responsibilities: A road crew member for the town is primarily responsible for the maintenance and repair of the town highway system and associated equipment. The On-Call road crew member assists two full-time Road Crew members on an as-needed basis in operating the equipment and working to maintain and repair the town facilities including, but not limited to road grading, trucking, snow plowing and sanding roads, brush clearing, road repair, mowing, light building and facility maintenance and other assigned tasks. Must have a high school diploma, GED, or equivalent; have the strength and stamina to do manual labor and work in adverse weather conditions. Valid Vermont Driver's License required; current, Vermont Commercial Driver's License (CDL) or eligibility therefore preferred. Five years of progressive experience in roadway maintenance or related field preferred.

The On-Call Crew Member has no set regular hours and is called in as-needed by the town Road Commissioner. Duties may require evening, night, weekend, and holiday work. Nonexempt position-eligible for overtime only as required by law. Bargaining unit position, currently represented by United Steelworkers.
