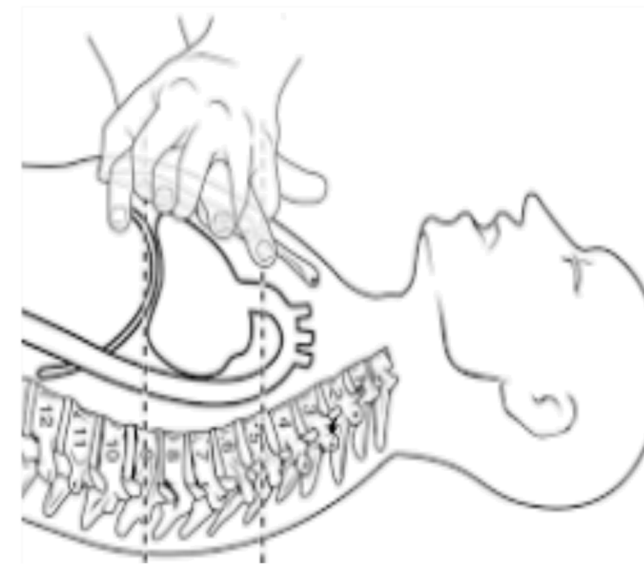

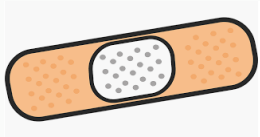

About

This workshop includes American Heart Association Heartsaver® First Aid CPR/AED and covers CPR/AED for adults and children and First Aid. It teaches students the critical skills needed to respond to and manage a first aid, choking or cardiac emergency in the first few minutes until trained medical professionals arrive.

It includes relief from choking, seizures, heart attack, diabetic emergencies, allergic reactions, EpiPen use, burns, bites, poisoning, broken bones, bleeding control, bandaging, glove removal, temperature-related emergencies, and how to aid with other life-threatening conditions.

Participants will practice life-saving skills during class.

Bloodborne Pathogens will cover how to stay safe and what to do in an emergency when blood is involved.

Audience

This course is intended for employees who respond to emergencies in the workplace or community and who need to learn how to protect themselves (and others) from exposure to blood or blood-containing materials.

On completion of this course participants will be able to:

- Assess the scene for safety and help to prevent illness or injury from becoming worse
- Provide necessary first aid within the workplace
- Understand and demonstrate essential life saving skills
- Understand how to handle an emergency when blood is involve
