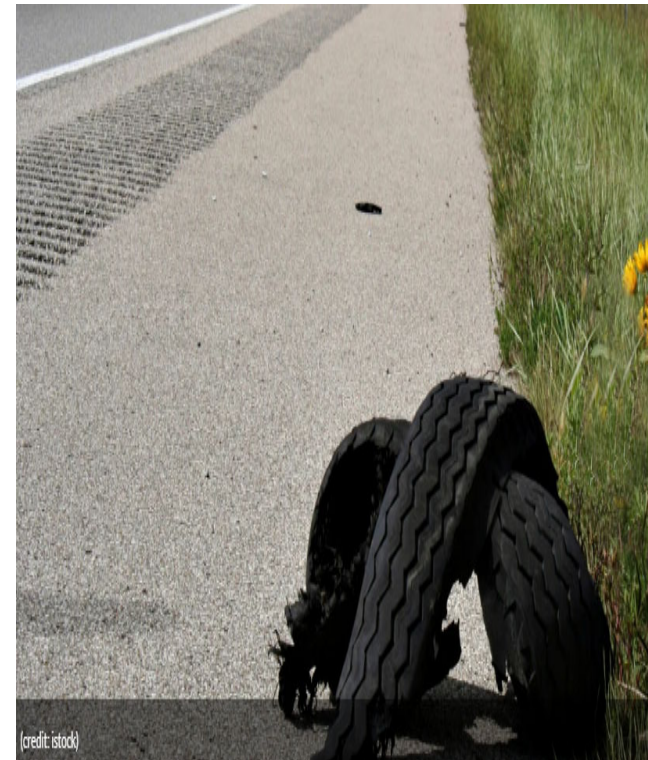

If the tire is free rolling and not slipping, a wet surface lubricates and cools the contact area of the tire, thereby causing it to wear at a slower rate.

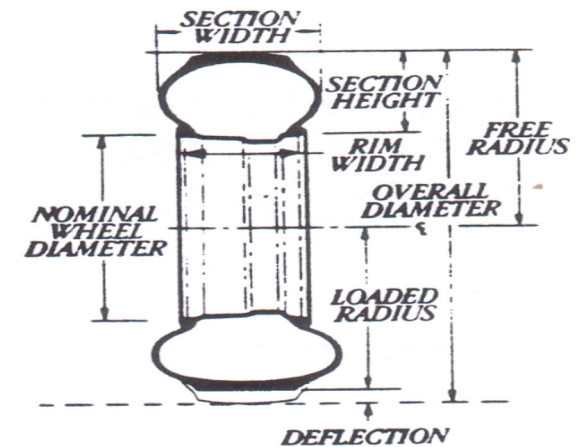
